

## APPENDIX A – PIIP PROJECTS

### EAST BERGHOLT INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT PLANS PRIORITIES FOR IMPLEMENTATION

#### Criteria for prioritising projects:

1. Project meets clear local need (a) essential (b) nice to have.
  2. There is no other sufficient funding form available or provides critical seed-corn funding to match other external funding
  3. How big the impact the project has, the benefit it will deliver. Can assess if impact is no people affected or other measure? Also subject measure eg: improve equality, safety, recreational wellbeing
  4. Deliver within a finite timeframe
  5. Contributes to PC or EBNP objectives
  6. Categories of large and small projects defined.
- Consider ring fencing a smaller sum of CIL grants in any one year for allocation to small projects.
  - Might want to ring fence around categories as well as around big/small projects

#### Levels of Priority matched to criteria above =

**HIGH LEVEL – RED;**

**SECOND LEVEL – ORANGE;**

**THIRD LEVEL – GREEN;**

**ITEMS DELIVERED THROUGH OTHER ORGANISATIONS OR PRECEPT - BLACK**

#### TRAFFIC MANGEMENT MEASURES

- a. 20 MPH LIMIT. Criteria Match: 1a, b, 3 whole village; 5; 6 large project.
- b. ENHANCED TRAFFIC CAMERAS. Criteria Match: 1,2,3 whole village; 4, 6?
- c. ELECTRIC CHARGERS IN CAR PARK Criteria Match: 1b,2;4;5; 6 small project?  
Not match 3 medium impact

NB PJA report may bring out other projects on road safety. These can be placed in the same group as traffic management issues

LAND FOR CAR PARKING Criteria match: 1a;2;3;4;5;6 Large project

FOOTPATH SYSTEM. Campaign and invest to make the footpaths accessible to all. Campaign and invest to provide safe and accessible footways (pavements) connecting all village properties with all village facilities
